## DIRECTIONS TO BELLEVUE COLLEGE

(formerly Bellevue Community College)

Bellevue College is SE of  
Bellevue city center and is reached via I-90.

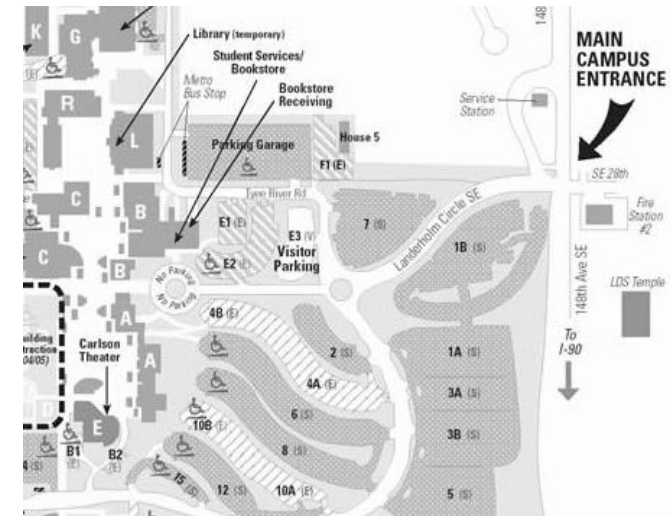
From either **I-5** or **I-405**, take the exit for I-90 headed east toward Spokane.

From **I-90**, take the **first exit east of Interstate 405**, which is Exit **11A** from the west and **Exit 11** from the east.

- **On I-90 Eastbound (as in approaching from Seattle or I-405):** Take exit **11A**, which cloverleafs **under** the overpass and takes you **north on 150th Ave SE**.
- **On I-90 Westbound (as in approaching from Eastern WA):** Take exit **11**, which branches into 3 branches. Take the exit to **156th** (see signs indicating Bellevue College). At the end of the exit ramp, turn **left** onto SE Eastgate Way. Go about 2 blocks and see **150th Ave SE**. Turn **right** (north) onto 150th Ave SE.

An auto dealership is on the right. 150th curves and spontaneously becomes 148th and then goes up a gradual incline, where the very large Mormon Temple can be seen on the R. **As you go up the hill, stay to the L and see 2 L-turn lanes.** Turn L and follow Landerholm Circle into the Bellevue College campus until you reach the end and find a circle drive. The **B Building** is very near this circle. Go back out and park anywhere in the parking areas and then come back to the circle, and find the B Building, where you will see signs to find the classroom, either **B-104** or **B-204**.
